Amy Yensi '02

Amy Yensi '02 is an award-winning journalist. She joined the PIX11 News team in July 2022. Most recently, she had worked at Spectrum News NY1 for more than four years. For her thorough, considerate journalism on the Covid-19 pandemic, the multimedia news organization City & State recognized her in 2020 as one of the Bronx Power 50 nonelected individuals who were moving the Bronx forward. Of Dominican descent, Amy also reported in Spanish at NY1 Noticias. Before her time at NY1, she was a general assignment reporter at WJZ in Baltimore for three years. There, she earned an Emmy nomination for her coverage of the Freddie Gray riots. Before WJZ, she was a “one-man band” reporter for News 12 The Bronx and Brooklyn, when she shot, wrote, and edited her own stories.

Amy's talents have been demonstrated on all platforms, including coordinating daily news coverage, assigning reporters and photographers to cover scheduled events and breaking news, writing scripts, editing video, conducting interviews, and reporting from the field. She has also pitched and written enterprise articles published in the New York *Daily News* and *Crain's New York Business*.

Amy earned her master's degree from the CUNY Graduate School of Journalism and her bachelor's degree in English from Hunter College. For the past three years, eager to share her experiences as a way to inspire young people to seek a career in journalism, Amy has been an adjunct professor at the Craig Newmark Graduate School of Journalism at CUNY.

Being fluent in speaking, writing, and reading Spanish has come in handy in the news business but also in Amy's travels around the world. When not on the air, she loves exploring New York City, trying new recipes, catching a Broadway show, and continuing her quest to find the best brunch in the city. Above all, she loves spending time with her one-year-old son Marcelo.



Taiboo Song '79

In 1976, Taiboo Song immigrated from Korea to the Bronx, holding close the American Dream; a dream that began and flourished at DeWitt Clinton High School.

In Korea, Taiboo's teachers were discipline focused. In contrast, Clinton provided Taiboo the opportunity to meet such teachers as Mr. Eric Nadelstern, who had a passion for teaching and, Taiboo could see, genuinely cared for him as a student. Taiboo did not know much English at first, but Mr. Nadelstern, as his ESL (English as a Second Language) teacher, pushed him to study hard and helped him to uncover the limitless opportunities available in the United States.

One opportunity was participating on the math team and taking part in a competition against the Bronx High School of Science. DeWitt Clinton's math team beat the Science math team and went on to win championships. DeWitt Clinton embraced Taiboo and treated him as a “Math King!” Upon reflection all these years later, Taiboo will tell you that DeWitt Clinton set the foundation for the person he is today.

With open doors and teachers who believed in him, Taiboo was able to attend MIT and graduate with a Bachelor of Science degree in electrical engineering. He then went on to accomplish much more:

- Taiboo designed the upper stage brain of Titan-Centaur, a rocket that was launched to the Moon and used by NASA for deep space missions.
- He designed the brake systems and in-flight entertainment systems for Boeing's 777 long-distance airplane.
- He invented the over-wing exit door for Boeing's domestic route airplanes, the 737NG and 737Max, which allows passengers to evacuate safely.
- He invented a new way of designing the interiors for the brand new 787 airplane and saved Boeing more than \$187 million dollars, which contributed to his receiving the Boeing Inventor Award - the company's highest award for technical achievement.
- He authored, developed, and taught three courses to more than 1,000 engineers at Boeing: Practical Electronic Design and Applications; Practical e-Enable Techniques and Applications; and Large-Scale Integration Science.

Taiboo believes he has been blessed by God. He has been heavily involved in his community by serving as the church elder board chair and board chair for a local church in Seattle. He has served as commander and game director for the Awana Program, a branch of the church's education department, and has taught children ranging from 3 to 18 years of age for more than 20 years. He has worked with more than 3,000 students, helping them memorize more than a combined 120,000 verses and reading more than 20,000 books. He also volunteers as an interview panel member for prospective MIT students, and participates as a judge for math competitions, science fairs and First Robotics.

After a 40-year career in aerospace, Taiboo recently took the next step into retirement. He lives happily in Washington State and has the most wonderful, supportive wife, and one son.



Curtis Urbina '75

Though a successful music publisher and label owner (Quark Records), Curtis Urbina first built his reputation as a champion high school wrestler. He was a member of the Clinton wrestling team that won several city team championships (1972-1975).

Curtis continued wrestling after his time at DWC and into the early 1980s. Along with DWC teammate, Stephen DeLorenzo, he started a youth program at the 63rd McBurney YMCA. They were also members of the adult wrestling team, participating in wrestling matches with local colleges. Curtis also participated in the NYC Maccabee Games, where he won several championships, and the prestigious New York Athletic Club (NYAC) Christmas Tournament.

Today, Curtis is very active in his community, utilizing the many skills he learned at DWC under the watchful guidance and kindness of his coach, Robert Stahli. Curtis is coach of the Newtown Youth Wrestling Program, a town program open to any child (boy or girl) wishing to learn valuable life lessons like commitment, focus, determination, and perseverance. The Newtown Youth wrestling team recently won its 8th consecutive league championship.

Curtis is also an active member of the Newtown-Sandy Hook Community Foundation (NSHCF.org). This group is committed to providing support to individuals and the community after the tragic events at Sandy Hook Elementary School on December 14, 2012. His daughter was in the school that terrible day and is a Sandy Hook student survivor.

In his professional life, Curtis has worked with music companies EMI, BMG/Sony, Atlantic Records, Universal, and Warner Music, also with artists Roger Daltrey, Ron Wood, Charlie Watts, Kid Rock, Deborah Gibson, Bobby Womack, Shannon, DJ Roger Sanchez, Blaze & many more.

While at EMI, he was the product manager for artists including The O'Jays, Najee, Evelyn "Champagne" King ("Shame"), Afrika Bambaata, George Thorogood & The Destroyers ("Bad To The Bone"). He spearheaded their marketing and promotional campaigns, creating major hits for them.

Curtis was instrumental in several successful dance music labels, creating the first opportunities for many of today's leading DJ/ producers & remixers. His dance music highlights include working for music labels such as Midsong Records, which had many major disco hits including the infamous "Fly Robin Fly" by Silver Convention. Also "Doctor's Orders" by Carol Douglas and Emergency Records, where Curtis was a partner and helped pave the way for hits like Kano's "I'm Ready" and Shannon's "Let The Music Play."

In 1987, he started his own imprint Quark Records, finding success in the exploding underground "house music" club scene. There he was instrumental in the success of acts like Blaze and Jomanda, which helped take the music genre to audiences overseas. The label hasn't looked back since and continues to be at the forefront of new styles on the club music scene. These include Techno, Drum 'n Bass, EDM and Chill. Many of Quark's releases can be heard on major playlists created for various companies in the Automotive, Clothing, Hotels, Salon & Spas, Fitness and Airlines industries.

He was also an adjunct professor at New York University where he taught courses on the Music Industry, the Business of Music Publishing, Careers in the Music Business, and Developing a Record Label. He continues to lecture on the current state of the music industry at Berklee College of Music in Boston.

What's more, he was instrumental in drafting a proposal which eventually led to the creation of two Grammy categories for Dance Music: "Best Dance/ Electronic Recording" and "Best Remix Recording, Non-Classical." He is also a member of the Legends of Vinyl's National Disco Hall of Fame.

Curtis is married to his amazing wife, Michelle, with two beautiful daughters, Lenie & Skylar.

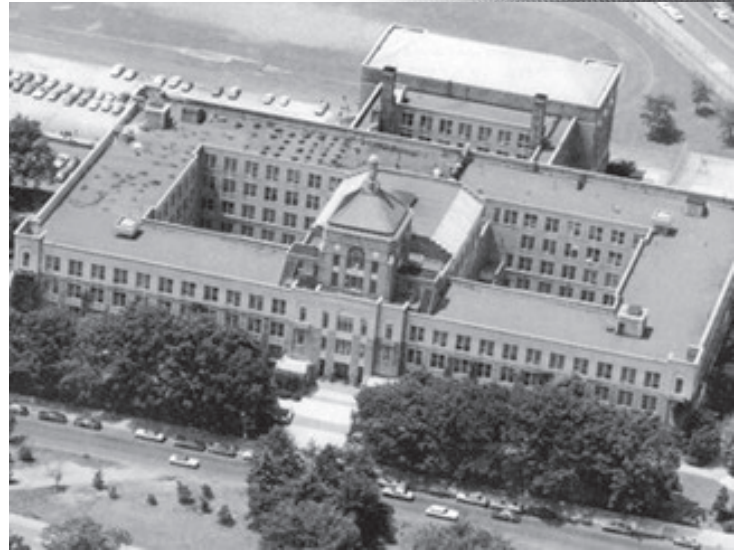

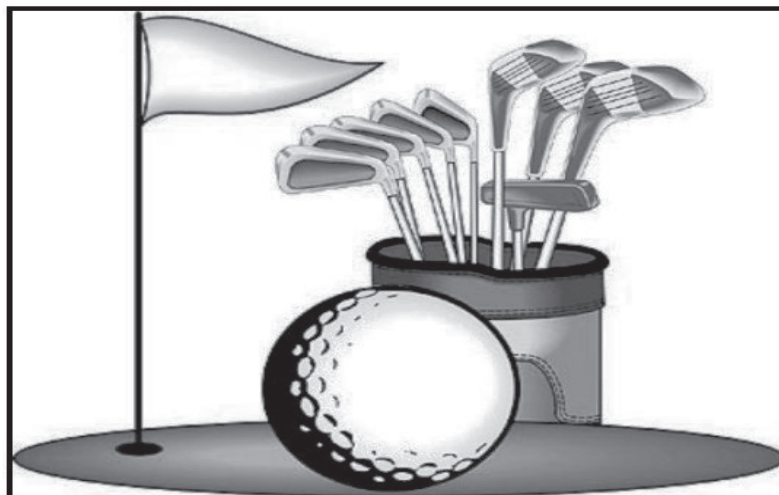
